

Training for New Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers and Lectors

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion serve our parish by their prayerful participation at weekly Mass and by ministering the Eucharist - the consecrated bread and the consecrated wine.

With additional training, Eucharistic Ministers may be assigned to bring Communion to the homebound.

Lectors serve our parish by their prayerful participation at weekly Mass and by preparing and effectively proclaiming the Word of God.

Do you feel God may be calling you to serve as a Eucharistic Minister or Lector?
