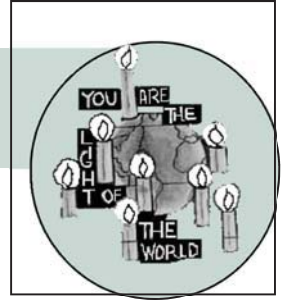


The Ministry of Praise

Just what is the Ministry of Praise?



Members of the Ministry of Praise commit to praying for intentions mailed to them from our parish. The type of prayer varies from person to person. Some pray the rosary; some pray prayers to particular saints; some remember these parish intentions at daily Mass; some pray in their own words, taking one intention a day.

In addition to the parish intentions, parishioners are invited to submit individual intentions. Both parish and individual intentions are mailed to Ministry of Praise members several times during the year.

*Serving in this ministry is open to anyone- men, women, young, not-so-young, homebound, working, retired. The key factor is being willing to make this commitment to prayer. There are no required meetings to attend!
You pray as you can, where you can, when you can!*
